In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 115 of the ²[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Ordinance, 2002 (³[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Ord, No.XIX of 2002), read with section 110 thereof, the Government ⁴[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] is please to make the following rules, namely;

<u>COMPENSATION FOR FORESTS OFFENCES AND</u> <u>VALUE OF CASE PROPERTY RULES. 2004.</u>

1. Short title and commencement: -

(1) These rules may be called the ⁵[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Compensation for the Forest Offences and value of Case property Rules, 2004

- (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definition: -
 - In these rules, unless the context otherwise require,
 "Appendix" means the appendix appended to these rules or such other appendix revised by Government from time to time.
 - (2) Other words and expressions used in these rules but not defined shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them under the Forest Ordinance, 2002 (⁶[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Ord. No. XIX of 2002), or any other law for the time being in force.
- 3. Rates of compensation: -The rates of compensation for forest offences for compounding by the Forest Officers shall be in accordance with Appendix-I to these rules.
- 4. Exempted Articles: -

The following wood articles/products obtained from the timber of lawful origin shall be exempted from the provisions of these rules:

- (i) Furniture articles accompanied with barat; and
- (ii) Coffin boxes for burial of dead.

5. Value of case property: -

- (1) The value of case property i.e. forest produce, implements, vehicles, vessels, receptacles, lorries, tools, animal and fashioned wood products for compounding forest offences cases by the Forest Officers shall be charge in accordance with the Appendix II to these rules.
- (2) Value of case property shall be charged at double the rate in the following cases:
 - (a) Forest offences committed between sunset and sunrise;
 - (b) Forest offences committed in the regeneration areas and research/sample plots;
 - (c) Forest offences committed by the same offender for the second and subsequent time.
- (3) In case of resistance, defiance or aggression to lawful authority, the value of case property i.e. forest produce, implements vehicles, boats, motor launches, receptacles lorries, vessels, animals and fashioned products shall be charged at three times the rates.

6. Walnut bark: -

Forest Offences regarding Walnut bark shall not be compounded under these rules by Any Forest Officer for any quantity what-so-ever. The same shall be seized and put to court for prosecution. After confiscation of produce under the orders of the court, the same shall be auctioned by the authorized Forest Officers.

7. Formulation of Procedure: -

Where any difficulty is being felt in the smooth functioning of these rules, the Chief Conservator may issue such instructions or directions, not inconsistent with these rules, as he may deem fit.
